## Update to Covid Policy as of 1/31/2022

Following discussion at the Legacy Board of Directors meeting on January 30, 2022, the following modification to our Covid Health and Safety policy was approved:

Beginning January 31, 2022, in the event of a positive Covid case within the school, the following actions will take place:

- Parents in the affected class, staff, and church leadership will be notified of a Covid exposure.
- Provided adequate staffing can be secured, the affected class will continue to operate in person on the regularly scheduled days.
- If adequate staffing CANNOT be secured, the affected class will close only until teachers/staff can be arranged.
- The student/staff member testing positive will be required to quarantine for a minimum of 5 days and may return on the 6<sup>th</sup> day if not exhibiting any sympoms.
- Parents are required to keep children exhibiting symptoms of <u>any illness</u> home until the symptoms have resolved.
- Parents will continue to CERTIFY the health of their child by requesting check-in on the Kangarootime app every day. Children that have not checked in may not be unloaded in carpool until the parent follows the proper procedure as outlined in the signed Health and Safety Screening Questions on file.

The Board of Directors and Legacy leadership reached this decision based upon the large number of recent Covid cases, exposures, and immunity (either through vaccinations or infections) among the Legacy students and staff. Our desire is to continue to provide an in-person learning experience as safely as possible. The update to our Covid policy is reflective of that priority. Parent and family cooperation is greatly appreciated.
