3-Year Old Learning Goals

Math

- Identify and practice writing numbers 1-15
- Count objects to 15
- Demonstrate one-to-one correspondence of objects
- Sort items by various attributes: color, shape, size
- Differentiate sizes: small, medium, large
- Learn shapes: square, rectangle, circle, triangle, oval

Literacy

- Introduce all 26 letters of the alphabet
- Learn to hold a crayon and marker correctly
- Build new vocabulary
- Build listening skills
- Develop fine motor skills using play-doh, scissors, and manipulatives

Social Skills

- Practice problem-solving skills in social situations
- Learn to share classroom materials, toys, books, etc.
- Practice using manners: please, thank you, excuse me, table manners
- Work on positively communicating his/her needs

Christianity

- Learn to sing a blessing and practice singing it before snack time daily
- Listen to Old and New Testament Bible stories, including stories about the life of Jesus
- Recognize that plants, animals, and humans are God's creations
- Learn Jesus' teachings to love God and love others
- Attend chapel weekly
